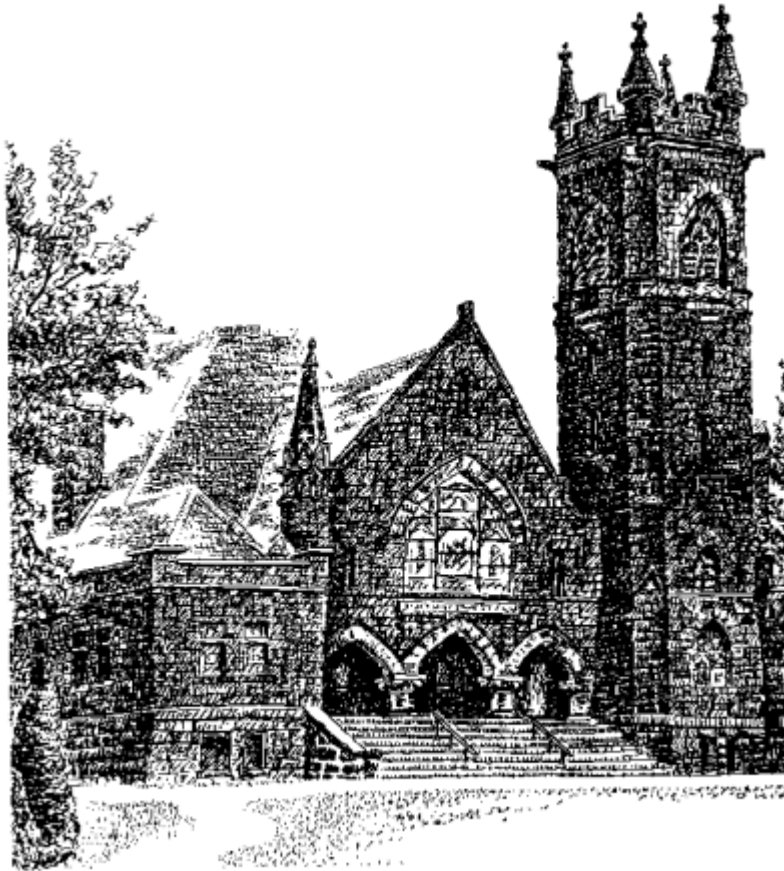

(That office was once Calvary's manse.) The Indiana Borough Parking Garage is located at 650 Water Street.

CROP HUNGER WALK – The final totals for the 2017 Indiana Area CROP Hunger Walk are in. The grand total for the entire event was \$8,977.78. It is time to celebrate Calvary's first place which was \$4,776.06, counting our Hoss's Community Day, Mission Lunch, offertory donations, and donations turned in the day of the walk. The Golden Shoe, for the third year in a row, is Calvary's. Trinity United Methodist Church came in a fairly close second. Donations were also received from Purchase Line United Methodist Church, Homer City Ministerium, Crete Presbyterian Church, Creekside United Methodist Church, First Unitarian Universalist Church of Indiana, Korean United Methodist Church and Christ Episcopal Church. Congratulations and thank you to all Indiana area walkers for a job well done!

ICCAP PRODUCT OF THE MONTH – In November we will collect holiday cooking basics, such as canned green beans and corn, canned jellied and whole cranberries, noodles, boxed stuffing, instant potatoes, boxed scalloped potatoes, jarred turkey gravy, canned onion rings, cream of mushroom soup and canned sweet potatoes, canned pumpkin, plus any other non-perishable items for both Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners.

FAMILY PROMISE (FP) – There are still vacancies on the FP volunteer chart for November 19 – 26. Granted, Thanksgiving week is a busy week for everyone as we are tied up with wonderful holiday preparations and possibly travel, but for the mother and child we will be hosting, it is just more of the same daily routine. They are busy with a different pursuit, that of working toward their goal of becoming independent, the same struggle of traveling from church to church, receiving counseling from Carole Reed, the mother working part-time and the son attending kindergarten. Thanksgiving Day and night will be covered by the Beckers. Currently, other volunteer needs are as follows:

- Sunday, November 19 – one sleepover volunteer (8 p.m. – 7 a.m.)
- Tuesday, November 21 – two sleepover volunteers (8 p.m. – 7 a.m.)
- Saturday, November 25 – cook and serve breakfast (8 – 10 a.m.)
- Saturday, November 25 – provide a small assortment of cut-up fruit and serve dinner with other food items already provided (4:30 p.m. – 6 p.m.)
- Sunday, November 26 – Eat a light lunch after church with the family and then drive them in the van to the Day Center.
- Any time after November 28 – pick up laundry (sheets, mattress covers and several blankets) wash them and take your time returning the clean items.

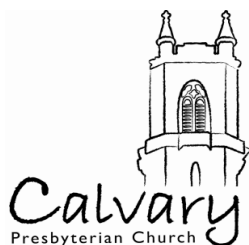
