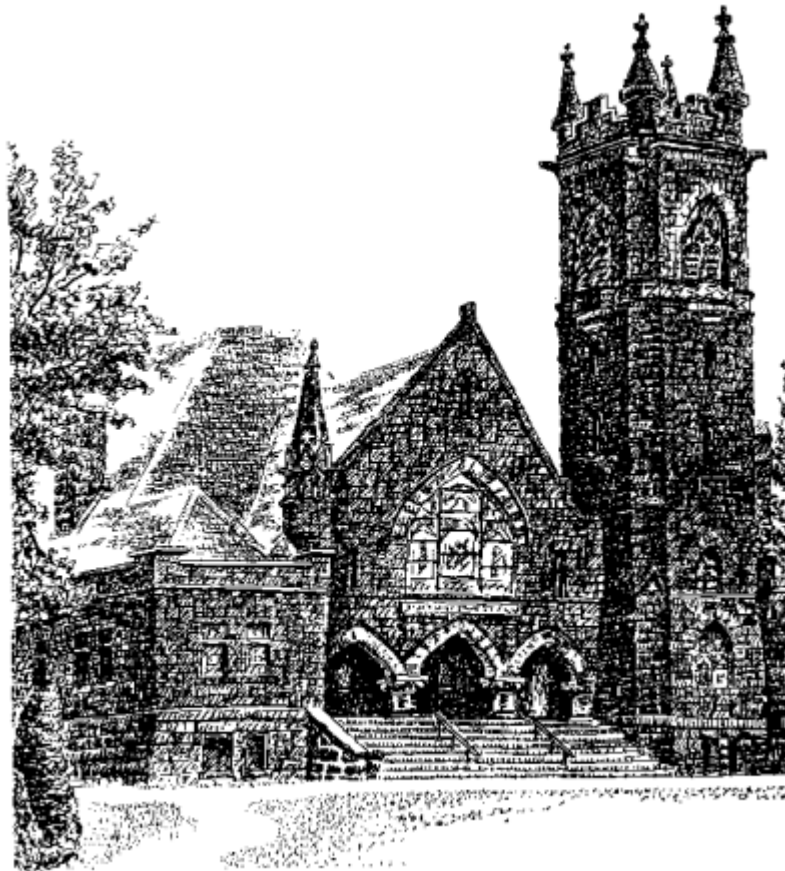

ANNOUNCEMENTS

TODAY IS PENTECOST – Fifty days after Christ’s resurrection, the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples on the day of Pentecost. Pentecost was an established Jewish festival also known as the Feast of Weeks, which drew people from many nations back to Jerusalem (Lev. 23:15-21; Deut. 16:16). Pentecost symbolizes a new beginning. It celebrates the unleashing of the Holy Spirit to empowering of the church to reach the world with the gospel of God’s love. In celebrating Pentecost, the church expresses its gratitude for the faithfulness of Christ in fulfilling his promise to send “another counselor” (John 14:16); celebrates the work of the Spirit in renewing all of creation; professes its confidence and security in knowing the Spirit’s power is available for its mission and ministry. The traditional color for Pentecost is red, after the flames described in Acts 2:3.

ICCAP FOOD OF THE MONTH – May’s list of foods to be donated to ICCAP includes, in general, all fruit products: canned or jarred fruit products, such as peaches, pears, apricots, fruit cocktail, fruit juices, children’s drink boxes or pouches, fruit rollups, packaged fruit cups, applesauce, dried fruits, jellies and preserves.

KINDNESS KITS – Donations for the following items are needed by May 27: washcloths, hand soap, tooth brushes, toothpaste, shampoo (two ounces or more). Kindness Kits will be available free of charge in early June to anyone wishing to participate in this “mission of kindness” to random strangers in need.
