

ANNOUNCEMENTS

BACK TO SCHOOL BASH (B2SB) – Can you believe it? B2SB is less than seven weeks away! Volunteer applications have been sent out to past volunteers. If you did not receive one, please pick one up at the Mission Table. We need volunteers in all areas of the event including set-up, tear-down, food, games, backpack sorting, loading and distribution, underwear and sock sorting, volunteer sign-in table and door prizes. If you cannot volunteer but wish to help, you may donate the following:

- multi-packs of chips, pretzels, crackers, etc.
- school supplies (lists will be available on the Mission Table soon)
- socks – black low socks for boys in sizes from pre-school through grade 12
- socks –low socks for girls in black, white or bright colors, in sizes as listed for boys
- both boys’ and girls’ underwear in all sizes (boxers for boys and all styles for girls)
- small items that could be used as game prizes (toys, school supplies, packaged edible items)
- cash donations through the offering (Write checks to Calvary and specify B2SB on memo line)

ICCAP COLLECTION – The products to be collected for ICCAP for July are all easy foods that can be served hot or cold, inside or outside: pasta salad mixes, canned baked beans, packaged cookies, packaged granola or other healthy snack bars, powdered fruit drink mixes, sandwich and salad condiments, peanut butter and jelly, canned tuna and chicken. These items will be collected through August 5.

LITTLE DRESSES – We are reviving our Little Dresses for Africa project from three years ago. The goal is to make 25-30 dresses by Rwanda Sunday, September 16. If you would like to help with Phase 1 of the project, we will assemble kits on July 16 at 1 p.m. in the dining room. This phase requires no sewing ability! We will provide the cut out dress, include all the sewing notions and directions in a plastic bag and have the kits ready for sewers to pickup Sunday, July 22. Phase 2 is the sewing phase and will begin July 22. This is take home work unless anyone wants a group workshop for the sewing. So bring your sharp scissors and come on July 16 if you can help assemble the kits.

HOSS’ COMMUNITY DAY – It will be Calvary Day at Hoss’s all day Thursday, July 19, and our rebate check will benefit Church Crisis Committee, which helps local people get caught up with their utility bills in times of crisis. Get your Hoss’s cards at the Mission Table or from Mission Committee members distributing them before services on July 8, and 15.


