

This year Calvary youth will take care of shopping and assembling the stockings. The Mission and Outreach Committee will have helpers on hand each Sunday to keep the process organized and flowing. The wrapped gifts will be due back and under the tree by December 9. Be sure the original paper ornament/tag is taped to the outside of the gift. Here are some pointers regarding your gifts:

- If you are ordering online, please do it now!
- Yes, we do have permission to wrap our gifts.
- If you have trouble finding an item, please call Becky Becker in the church office for some assistance. Help is just a phone call away at (724) 463-9197.
- If you wish to put an extra item in with your wrapped gift, that is permissible.
- If your tag is for boots or shoes, check Walmart, Payless Shoesource and the Shoe Dept.
- If you cannot shop, consider picking one of the plaid paper bow ties from the tree representing \$25 gift cards at Walmart or ALDIs to be used for food items for a Christmas dinner for each family.
- Please don't stress; this is supposed to be Christmas fun!

CROP HUNGER WALK RESULTS – First the good news: The total collected for the Indiana Area CROP Hunger Walk will be over \$8,000. That means \$6,000 will go for world hunger projects and \$2,000 will be forward to our own ICCAP for the food bank. Now some other news (not necessarily bad) Trinity United Methodist Church will possess the Golden Shoe for the coming year with a total of over \$4,000. Calvary's total was \$2,430.53, "which is nothing to sneeze at!" Thank you for your support on such a cold and wet day.


