

Some suggestions are cans of soup or stew, dry soup mixes, hot cereals, canned ingredients for chili, pasta and noodle meal kits, stewed tomatoes, any canned vegetables and broth that could be the basis of a soup.

CROP HUNGER WALK – The annual Indiana County CROP Hunger Walk will be on Sunday, October 13, with registration beginning at 12:30 p.m. and the Walk at 1:00 p.m. Materials are on the Mission Table. This year is the fiftieth anniversary of the national event and some special features will be added to the event in celebration of that milestone. **Food fact number 1:** Church World Service (CWS) provides communities with emergency food help when situations are desperate. CWS provides food assistance in more than 40 countries. Money collected through CROP Hunger Walk is divided with 75% of donations designated for world hunger projects and 25%, local, in our case, Indiana County Community Action Program (ICCAP).


